The method to change the aperture in Manual mode is slightly different. If you try onlyturning the dial, as you would in A mode, you'll find that it adjusts the shutter speed. But you use that same dial while holding down the +/- button on top at the same time. It's the button next to the shutter button.

*How to Change Aperture on Nikon D3500*

First, make sure that the dial on the top of the camera is set to \"M\" position. Next, press and hold the +/- button located right below the camera shutter, then rotate the rear command dial to change aperture. Rotating to the left will decrease the aperture, while rotating to the right will increase the aperture.

*How to Change Aperture on Nikon D3000 and D5000*

To adjust shutter speed: Rotate the Main dial. To adjust aperture: Rotate the Quick Control dial.

*Setting Exposure: Shutter Speed and Aperture*

If you choose, for example, to be in your Aperture Priority mode – indicated on the top left hand ring as A, then the aperture will be your priority. In this case, you will simply move the right-hand ring to select a chosen aperture and the in-camera light meter will do the rest, letting you know what shutter speed you'll be working with from your chosen aperture.

Now, we start to learn how to adjust aperture on Nikon D3100. First of all, make sure your camera is on. Then you have to press the button next to the shutter release and the info button on the top of the camera. You have to press and hold this button at once while you are moving the dial to the left or the right.

Note: To get full control of your camera's shutter speed and aperture values you need to put it in Manual Mode. What happens when you adjust the aperture value. When you increase the aperture value the aperture opening inside the lens gets smaller, reducing the amount of light that can enter the camera. Similarly, when you decrease the ...

*How to Use Shutter Speed and Aperture Together When Using ...*

Let's know how to change the aperture for both the series of canon-How to Change Aperture on your Canon Rebel Series Camera: Grab the camera. Set the Manual Mode. Suppress the Shutter Release Button. Leave the button when the Meter becomes activated. Use your Thumb to hold the AV button (at the back of your canon camera).

Although I can change the aperture from the camera (in M mode) it seems that it is not changing in photos. What I mean: The aperture is locked in f/22 and I am able to select all values (1.8 – 22) from the camera switch. The problem is that in every shoot the photos have exactly the same aperture, ignoring my initial selection in camera.

*Why doesn't the aperture change on a Nikon AF 50mm f/1.8D ...*

The change in aperture size correlates with exposure. The larger the aperture size, the more exposed the photo will be and vice versa. The best way to demonstrate this is by taking a series of photos and keeping everything constant with the exception of the aperture.
